GLOBAL CLIMATE CHANGE POSTER

DUE DATE: Day of our Final Exam

For our final exam you will be creating a poster on global climate change. You will need to follow the instructions below and **create a 24" x 36" poster & prepare a 5-6 minute presentation** to the class about your poster.

Your poster is to address the following questions and have a **single theme throughout**.

1. What is ONE reason we are experiencing GLOBAL CLIMATE CHANGE right now?

In this section you will need to identify one major source of global climate change (as determined by scientists) and **write 200-300 words** explaining this problem: what the problem is; where the source of the problem comes from; how scientists know it is a problem; WHY it is a problem; etc.

2. What is ONE of the anticipated affects of GLOBAL CLIMATE CHANGE (especially considering your choice of examples in part 1?)

In this section you will need to identify one major expected outcome of global climate change (as determined by scientists) and **write 200-300 words** explaining this potential outcome: what is this expected outcome; where do scientists expect these outcomes to happen (who will they affect); how scientists have figured out it is going to be a problem; etc.

3. What is ONE of the possible ways we can help to lessen (or prevent) this expected outcome from GLOBAL CLIMATE CHANGE (especially considering your choice in part 2?)

In this section you will need to consider and discuss one major change that people or governments can make to offset the expected outcomes of global climate change (as you have outlined in part 2) and **write 200-300 words** explaining your proposal: what is your proposal; what would be necessary to occur in order for it actually happen (in the real world); how will it make a difference in global climate change; do you think it will really happen (or will people ignore your ideas; etc.

The poster will have three parts – and should include your printed text (see above) as well as images, drawings, charts, graphs, photographs, etc. I expect you to also include a short bibliography of sources used.

**This CAN BE a very fun assignment AND it counts as your FINAL EXAM!
However you need to take this VERY SERIOUSLY
as it is a MAJOR portion of YOUR FINAL GRADE!**
